**The Pearl.** At one time, illustrations were a crucial part of a book's popularity and skilled illustrators were paid very well. But the illustrators were given direction by the publisher and lead editors. You are pretending to be a publisher.

After reading the novella, choose FOUR scenes from the book that you would illustrate in order to depict crucial plot points. Include the following:

- 1. Physical background. Indoor or outdoor. Describe the setting, the landscape, the lighting. Every detail should be given. Is it black & white, or color? Why?
- 2. Characters. Give the names, ages, appearances. Describe their expressions.
- 3. Mood. What should the reader feel when seeing the drawing?

**Farewell to Manzanar**. After finishing chapter 11, read the following poem, "I Ask My Mother to Sing" by Li Young-Lee.

- 1. Why do the speaker's grandmothers cry as they sing about China?
- 2. How does this compare to the sadness that Jeanne's papa experiences while singing the national anthem?
- 3. Have you ever become emotional listening to songs about our country? Explain your answer. If not, are there any songs at all which make you emotional?

**Readers' Choice**: Give the genre, the main character names, and a brief explanation of why you would recommend the book you chose.
